

## NOTICE

### TO: **Customers of Prodigy Wealth Management Corp.**

On November 18, 2009, the Investment Industry Regulatory Organization of Canada announced that it had suspended the membership of Prodigy Wealth Management Corp. ("Prodigy Wealth"). Prodigy Wealth has ceased dealing with the public and customer accounts were transferred to Canaccord Capital Corporation on November 2, 2009.

The Canadian Investor Protection Fund/Fonds canadien de protection des épargnants ("CIPF") understands that Prodigy Wealth has ceased business but does not have complete information as to its financial status. However, customers with accounts at Prodigy Wealth who have suffered or may suffer financial loss solely as a result of Prodigy Wealth being or becoming insolvent may be eligible for coverage for such losses by CIPF to prescribed limits. Such losses must result from the failure of Prodigy Wealth to return or account for securities, cash balances, commodities, futures contracts, segregated insurance funds or certain other property acquired or held by Prodigy Wealth in an account for customers. Losses that do not result from the insolvency of Prodigy Wealth such as losses arising from changing market values of securities, unsuitable investments or the default of an issuer of securities are not eligible for CIPF coverage.
